Thank you for your interest in the **Ten Commandments Hike** route takes participants to ten houses of worship. At each stop participants will hear a short presentation about that faith and one of the Ten Commandments. Our hike will be lead by Moses and the group will be divided into the 12 Tribes of Israel. Each tribe will be lead by a “son of Jacob”. This will be a rare opportunity for Boy Scouts, Cub Scouts and Girl Scouts, third grade and older, to share an experience demonstrating their *Duty to God* while they *Serve God* and learn of other religions.

**Participants must pre-register by March 1.** You will then receive additional information about the hike details, instructions and typical questions. Better yet, you will receive your patches the day of the hike, instead of seven weeks later. (Scouts not pre-registered will be allowed to participate only if space permits and will not receive a patch.)

A few notes:

- Wear your uniforms. If you like, bring your flags, but *you* get to carry them for the distance.
- The 5-mile Hike (with lunch break) will last approximately six hours, from 9:00 – 3:00.
- The Hike will proceed whatever the weather, so “Be Prepared.”
- Youth Protection Guidelines must be followed. An individual Scout may participate with a parent. A pack, den, troop, patrol or crew may participate as a group with a minimum of two registered leaders, or one registered leader and a parent. Leaders must have their youth and adult medical forms in their possession.
- The Hike will begin at St. Nicholas Greek Orthodox Church, 697 Asheville Hwy Spartanburg, SC and conclude at St. John’s Lutheran Church, 415 S. Pine St.
- Drivers will drop off at St. Nicholas, park at St. John’s and be “bussed” back to St. Nicholas.
- Report to the registrar in the church starting at 8:15, but no later than 8:45.
- At the registration table
  - Receive a copy of the hike route
  - Receive any additional information and instructions.
  - Be assigned to one of the 12 “Tribes of Israel”
- The cost of the Hike will be \$5.00 per person due with your pre-registration form.
- You will carry your own sack lunch and drink on the hike. Put it in a backpack along with any other “gear” you might need.
